ANNEXURE

Any D-2/JKEL-6 unit opting for production of RTD shall be required to install additional machinery and equipment/modification, which may also require alteration of the licensed premises. Permission for installation of required additional machinery/equipment and alteration of licensed premises shall be granted under Rule 52 of J&K Distillery Rules,1946 as per following procedure: -

1. D-2/JKEL-6 licensee shall apply to the Excise Commissioner for permission for installation of additional machinery and equipment /alteration of licensed premises required for production of RTD.
2. The Excise Commissioner shall forward the application to Deputy Excise Commissioner Distilleries for further processing.
3. Licensee shall submit following documents to the Deputy Excise Commissioner, Distilleries:
 - i. Proposed blueprints (05 Nos.)
 - ii. Processing fee of Rs. 5000/- (Non-refundable) required under Rule 39(a) of J&K Liquor License & Sales Rules, 1984.
 - iii. Detailed Project report.
4. Deputy Excise Commissioner, Distilleries after examining the viability shall recommend the case to the Excise Commissioner.
5. Excise Commissioner may grant permission for manufacturing of RTD within the licensed premises which shall be subject to the existing terms and conditions of D-2 and JKEL-6 licenses and after payment of the annual license fee as applicable under the Policy Year.
