Sub: Renewal of Liquor Licenses.

In pursuance of Excise Policy 2017-18, it is hereby ordered that all the liquor licenses henceforth shall be renewed for a period of five years subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The licensee shall submit a **No Dues** certificate/ **NoC** issued by the Commissioner, Commercial Taxes, J&K with respect to payment of all sales tax dues upto 31st August 2017.
- ii. The licensee shall deposit the annual license fee as may be prescribed from time to time within a period of ten days and also abide by other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Excise Policy in vogue.
- iii. The license shall be suspended/ terminated/ cancelled in case of any violation of the section 22 of the J&K Excise Act, 1958 or any other terms and conditions prescribed by the Excise Policy.
