SRINAGAR THE 2nd JUNE 2004

SRO 164 :- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3A, 12, 20 and 25 of the Jammu and Kashmir Excise Act, Sarvati 1958, the Government hereby directs that at the end of rule 28 of the Jammu and Kashmir Liquor Licence and Sales Rules, 1984, the following provisos shall be added; namely:-

"Provided that the Excise Commissioner may with a view to arrest bootlegging or illicit distillation in an unserved or underserved area or when he feels expedient to do so in the interest of Government revenue, allow sale of liquor temporarily off the premises at a sub-vend through a licensee already holding a licence in form JKEL2 for the nearest existing vend, for such period and on such terms and conditions as he may deem necessary;

- Provided further that the premises of the sub-vend shall be duly reflected in form JKEL-2 as a part of the main vend and all transaction through the said sub-vend shall for all intents and purposes be treated as transactions through the main vend."
