SRO 432 .- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 of the Jammu and Kashmir Excise Act, Samvat, 1958 (1901 A.D), the Government hereby direct that in the Jammu and Kashmir Distillery Rules, 1946, the following amendments shall be made; namely:-

- (i) in rule 2 the words " Excise and Taxation Commissioner" wherever occurring, shall be substituted by the words "Excise Commissioner";
- (ii) in rule 5, in clause (a), for the letters and figures " Rs. 2,000" and "Rs. 5,000" the words "one lac rupees" and "two lac rupees" respectively shall be substituted;
- (iii) in rule 5, clause (c) shall be substituted by the following:

"Paid a license fee to be determined by the Government by notification from time to time"; and

- (iv) rule 6, shall be substituted by the following:-
"The license shall be in form D-2 and shall be non-transferable:

Provided that the Excise Commissioner may for sufficient and cogent reasons to be recorded in writing, on an application from the original licensee(s) and subject to payment of non-refundable transfer fee of rupees one lac, transfer the license during its currency to any other person or add the name(s) of any other person(s) in the license as partner(s) or delete the name of any partner from the license, if such person(s) is/are otherwise eligible under these rules for grant of license and on such transfer, addition or deletion all such partners shall be responsible for all obligations incurred, or to be incurred, under the license during the period of its currency as if it had originally been granted or renewed in his/her/their name(s)"


