It has been observed with dismay the applications of various licences/firms for approval of labels or grant of permits for import of spirit etc are inordinately delayed in the offices of the Deputy Excise Commissioners. In few cases the cases have been retained for months together. This is an alarming situation and seems to have become a breeding ground for corruption.

It is, therefore, impressed upon all concerned that disposal of the cases indicated above should be made within two days and in no case it should take more than one week in any case. In the letters addressed to the Excise Commissioner the date of receipt of application from the licensee/firm should invariably be indicated.

Contravention of the above instructions will invite disciplinary action.
