Bid Document for e-Auction of JKEL-2 for the year 2025-26.

Reference:

Finance Department's letter No: FD-7/2023-03 dated 15.02.2025

No: 63 -EC of 2025 Dated:15-02-2025

In pursuance to the approval of the Finance Department vide above referent letter, the e-auction of retail liquor vends (JKEL-2) for the year 2025-26 shall be held in accordance with the following provisions.

I. PROCEDURE FOR ALLOTMENT OF RETAIL SALE VENDS OFF-PREMISES (JKEL-2 VENDS) IN UNION TERRITORY OF JAMMU & KASHMIR:

Retail Vends (JKEL-2) shall be allotted in the form of individual units for the year 2025-26. Each licensed vend will be authorized to sell JK Special Whisky, JK Country Liquor and Indian Made Foreign Liquor including Imported Foreign Liquor/Beer/Wine/Cider/RTD under one roof. The bid shall be on the license fee only. For MRP calculation/Duty Structure/ Profit margin and prevailing norms/rules, each bidder is advised to refer the J&K Excise Act, 1958 Svt., the J&K Liquor License and Sale Rules, 1984 and other rules/amendments/notifications made there under from time to time and the J&K Excise Policy 2025-26. Each bidder in his own interest is advised to bid carefully keeping in view the sale potential of the location and profit margins as notified in the J&K Excise Policy 2025-26.

II. MODE OF ALLOTMENT:

The allotment of vends shall be made through e-auction portal https://jkexcisedept.procure247.com through J&K Bank in a completely secure and transparent manner. The detailed procedure for e-auction bidding /instructions to the bidders are available on the e-auction portal and on the official website of the Department i.e.



www.jkexcise.nic.in.

In case of locations, where no response is received in e-auction, the same shall be re-auctioned in the same manner, as above.

The Licensing Authority/Department reserves the right to cancel the eauction process for a location where poor/inadequate response etc. in terms of participation of bidders or less Bid Amount in comparison to the sale potential of the location or earlier quoted bids received, even after declaration of H1 bidder.

Further, the Licensing Authority, in the interest of government revenue, may proceed in terms of Para 2.3.8 of the J&K Excise Policy, 2025-26 for making the vends operational immediately after determination of existing JKEL-2 licenses on 31st March, 2025.

III. LOCATION OF LIQUOR VENDS:

The licenses for retail vend shall be granted at the locations specified in the **Annexure-A** to this document.

The Department shall not be responsible for providing space. The bidder shall arrange suitable premises in consonance with the conditions given in <u>Para (IX)</u> of this document. No extension in time; or concession in any fee, duty or any other levy by whatever name called, shall be allowed on account of failure of the bidder to arrange the premises for making the license operational from the date of commencement of sale operation as indicated in this document/decided by the Excise Department.

IV. ENTITIES THAT CAN APPLY FOR LICENSE:

The licenses for retail liquor vends for off-premises consumption shall be issued only in favour of:

- i) An individual
- ii) A partnership firm.
- iii) A body incorporated under the Companies Act 1956.
- iv) A society registered under J&K Cooperative Societies Act.

V. NUMBER OF VENDS THAT CAN BE BID FOR:

A Bidder can apply for any number of vends and shall have to pay the application fee/EMD separately for each bid by the bidder from his KYC/PAN linked bank accounts for each such bid. However, to obviate the possibility of cartelization and monopolistic practices, only one vend shall be allotted to a successful bidder for which his /her bid is the highest and in case of successful bidders paying the EMD/Bid Amount from a joint Bank Account linked with his/her KYC/PAN, all joint account holders become ineligible for staking claim as H1 Bidder for any other location. The timing of bid for vends within Excise Range shall be separate. The Districts and Locations within Excise Range shall be put to e-auction as per e-auction schedule notified by the department. In case a bidder is Highest i.e. H-1 at the time of closing of bid of a vend, he/she in his/her own interest is advised not to bid for other vends subsequently. In case he/she bids at other vends after being H-1 at a location where bidding has closed, he/she will be allotted the location for which the H1 bid quoted by him is highest and his/her EMD of all other vends except the allotted vend shall be forfeited.

Further, mere declaration of H1/successful bidder for a location shall not qualify the H1 bidder to obtain the JKEL-2 license for a location. The H1/successful bidder shall have to qualify all other eligibility criteria and Terms & Conditions notified in the Excise Policy for obtaining the JKEL-2 license.

VI. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The Bidder should fulfil the following criteria:

- a. The Bidder should not be below the age of 21 years on the 1st January, 2025 (i.e. year in which the auction is being held).
- b. The Bidder should be a domicile of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir.
- c. The Bidder should have immovable property in UT of J&K worth upto 100% of the Minimum Reserve Bid Value/Price or not less than 50% of the Minimum Reserve Bid Value/Price with the remainder of

Minimum Reserve Bid Value/Price (not more than 50% as Bank Guarantee (BG). The Bidder shall produce an Immovable Property Certificate and Bank Guarantee as the case may be to this effect from the competent revenue/Bank Authority.

- d. The Bidder should not be convicted of any non-bailable offence by a Criminal Court.
- e. The Bidder should not have been charge sheeted by any court of law under any offence involving moral turpitude.
- f. The Bidder should not be convicted, or reasonably suspected of committing or conniving at the commission of any non-bailable offence under the J&K Excise Act, Svt. 1958 or NDPS Act, 1985 and shall produce a character certificate issued by the concerned District Superintendent of Police.
- g. The Bidder should not be a defaulter of State Taxes Department under the J&K General Sales Tax Act 1962, Central Sales Tax Act and J&K Excise Act Syt. 1958.
- h. The Bidder should have nothing outstanding against previous transactions in trade/duties/fees with the Excise Department.
- i. The Bidder should make his/her own arrangement for a shop/premises at the location (owned /leased/rented).
- j. The Bidder should be of sound mental health to conduct the business.
- k. The Bidder should have paid from his own KYC/PAN linked account, the non-refundable application/ registration fee of Rs.75,000/- and EMD of Rs.10.00 Lacs.
- 1. The Bidder should not have been debarred from holding license for the sale of any intoxicant in J&K, Punjab, Delhi, Haryana, UT of Chandigarh or Himachal Pradesh for which he will have to furnish an affidavit duly attested by 1st Class Magistrate.
- m. The Bidder should not be in possession of license of manufacturing unit viz. Distilleries/Bottling Plant/Brewery.
- n. The Bidder should not be in conflict of Rule 18, 19(1) and 19(2) of J&K Liquor License and Sale Rules, 1984.
- o. The Bidders who had failed to deposit the bid amount in the

auctions held in the year 2021-22 onwards shall be ineligible to participate in the e-auction for the year 2025-26.

VII. Documents to be submitted with e-bid:

- a) Earnest Money Deposit of Rs Ten Lakh shall be deposited by the bidder from his KYC/PAN linked account number through the link provided in the portal.
- b) Affidavits duly executed before Magistrate affirming that:
 - The bidder has not been convicted of any non-bailable offence by a criminal court.
 - ii. The bidder has not been convicted, or reasonably suspected of committing or conniving at the commission of any non-bailable offence under the J&K Excise Act, Svt. 1958 or NDPS Act, 1985 and shall produce a character certificate issued by the concerned District Superintendent of Police.
 - iii. The bidder is not a defaulter of State Taxes Department under the J&K General Sales Tax Act 1962, Central Sales Tax Act and J&K Excise Act Svt. 1958.
 - iv. The bidder is in his possession/has made arrangement for ensuring availability of premises on ownership/Lease /rent deed duly registered with the competent registering authority in the area/location for which bid is offered.
 - v. The bidder has submitted only one bid for the given location whether in his individual capacity or in partnership or as member of cooperative society or Director of Company or its representative.
 - vi. The bidder has paid Registration fee, EMD and Bid Amount from his KYC/PAN linked account(s).
 - vii. Grant of JKEL-2 License to the bidder is not in conflict of para 4 of the J&K Excise Policy 2025-26, Rule 18, 19(1) and 19(2) of J&K Liquor License and Sale Rules.
 - viii. The bidder is not a defaulter of the Excise Department.



- ix. The bidder has not been debarred from holding license for the sale of any intoxicant in J&K, Punjab, Delhi, Haryana, UT of Chandigarh or Himachal Pradesh.
- x. The bidder is bidding as individual/partner/director/member (as applicable) and is a domicile of UT of J&K.

 The partnership deed/registration/resolution (as applicable) have already been made before bidding.
- xi. Solvency/Immovable Property Certificate as per Para VI (c).
- xii. Copy of Bank Guarantee.
- c. Recent passport size Photographs of individual/all partners/directors /members as may be applicable.
- d. Domicile certificate of individual/all partners/directors/members as may be applicable.
- e. Copy of PAN and Aadhar of individual/all partners/directors/ members as may be applicable.

VIII. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION FOR E-AUCTION

The bidders shall ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility criteria as laid in the J&K Excise Act (Svt.) 1958, Rules made thereunder and J&K Excise Policy 2025-26 before participating in the bidding process. No verification of the disclosures shall be carried out by the Excise Department at the bidding stage. Upon conclusion of the process, if the successful bidder is found to be not fulfilling any of the eligibility criteria or fails to fulfil any condition subsequent to the bidding process, or does not fulfil the requirements mentioned in this tender document or refuses to accept the offer at quoted bid, the EMD and Bid Amount shall be forfeited, and no claim whatsoever shall lie against the Excise Department/ Govt. of J&K on this account.

IX. SUITABILITY OF LOCATION FOR VEND TO BE ENSURED BY THE BIDDER:

The successful bidder shall make his own arrangement for a shop/premises in the specified area (owned/leased/rented). In case the successful bidder is not able to arrange a suitable premises at the

notified location he may arrange the premises in the adjoining Revenue village (in case of rural areas) or in the adjoining ward (in case Municipal Committee/ Municipal Council) or to a suitable location with a revenue/tourist potential in terms of para 2.3.10 of the J&K Excise Policy 2025-26. The bidder shall ensure that the premises selected/identified by him meets the requirements of the J&K Excise Act and Rules/Notifications (J&K Excise Policy, 2025-26) made thereunder and including directions by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard and other competent courts of law, if any. The bidder shall apply for clearance of the premises from the District Magistrate after being declared as H1. The regular license on the newly identified /selected premises/shop shall be issued only after getting clearance from the District Magistrate concerned. The District Magistrate shall convey the clearance or otherwise of the newly identified premises within a period of 15 days from the receipt of application from the H1 bidder, in case of non-disposal of application, the premises shall be deemed to have been cleared by the District Magistrate.

However, in order to ensure against any loss of revenue to the Government, due to delays in operationalization of vends, no clearance of District Magistrate shall be required for the premises chosen by the H1 bidder where vends were operational in previous years.

Further, licensing authority in the interest of government revenue, may proceed under sub-rule-8 of rule-30 of J&K Liquor License and Sale Rules 1984 for making JKEL-2 vends operational immediately after determination of existing licensees to avoid loss of time in arranging for the NoCs or requisite documents by the successful bidders for opening of vend.

Successful bidders who are not able to establish their vends in suitable private buildings may approach the concerned District Magistrate who shall ensure, in the interest of government revenue, that such licensees/H1 bidders are provided with the government

land within 15 days, where they can build their temporary structures with reasonable rent or open their vend as the case may be.

The bidder can also make any arrangement for premises or land for the policy year 2025-26 (for erecting temporary structure) available with the Authorities/Departments/Institutions/Corporations/ULBs /PRIs etc.

Also, Power Development Department (i.e concerned Power Distribution Corporation Ltd) shall also provide electricity in such temporary structures within 5 days where such retail vends are being run and the licenses shall be bound to pay the electricity bills. After determination of license, the property shall be restored to the Government/Authority/Department/Institution/Corporations/ULBs /PRIs with removal of temporary structures. The licensee shall make adequate Fire Safety Arrangements in their premises.

For obtaining Immovable Property Certificate/Solvency Certificate in terms of para 2.3.3 of J&K Excise Policy 2025-26, the vendor must apply within 20 days of issuance of license before the concerned Revenue Authority. The competent authority shall issue the requisite certificate within a period of one month from the date of receipt of application from the H1 bidder or as per the timelines indicated in the J&K Public Service Guarantee Act, 2011, whichever is earlier. In case of non- disposal of application after the prescribed timeline, the certificate shall be deemed to have been issued by the competent authority as claimed by the applicant.

An individual to whom a license is granted in form JKEL-2/ Type C may preferably establish the vend 50 meters away from any recognised educational institute and religious place.

X. PARTICIPATION/ REGISTRATION FEE:

Non-refundable/non-adjustable Participation/Registration Fee of Rupees Seventy-Five thousand is to be paid online through portal as per the link provided. In case of non- participation in the bidding process, the registration fee shall stand forfeited.

XI. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT AND MINIMUM RESERVE PRICE

Earnest Money Deposit of Rupees Ten Lacs shall be deposited by the bidder from his KYC/PAN linked account number through the link provided in the portal. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned by the Department.

The Minimum Reserve Bid Price to bid for each vend/location shall be as per Annexure A to this document.

XII. AUCTIONING PROCESS:

Detailed steps of the e-auction process are available on e-auction portal https://ikexcisedept.procure247.com. Bidders are advised to familiarize themselves with the same. In case of any query, the prospective bidders may also contact the Help Desk established by the Excise Department.

XIII. SUBSEQUENT CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BY THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER:

Payment of bid amount

- (i) The successful bidder will be required to deposit an amount equal to 100% of total bid amount under major head 0039 through e-GRAS/e-Collect portal within seven bank working days from the date of finalization of bid for a vend.
- (ii) EMD deposited by the H1 Bidder for any other unsuccessful location(s), shall be adjusted against the Bid amount quoted by the H1 Bidder for a particular location (to be deposited within 07 bank working days) subject to the condition that he/she has not defaulted on any of such unsuccessful location(s). The bidder shall make representation and undertaking to concerned DEC Executive for adjustment of EMD(s) pertaining to unsuccessful locations forthwith the declaration of H1 bidder.
- (iii) If the successful bidder fails to comply with the aforesaid conditions of payment of bid money within the prescribed period, the Earnest Money and the Bid Amount, if any, (less than total Bid Amount) deposited shall be forfeited. In such a case, the liability of the highest

bidder will not be limited only to the extent of earnest money tendered by him in the auction process for a particular location, but any other allotment in which he is a stake holder shall also be cancelled, the respective deposits made in the form of Earnest Money or security for such other bids shall also be forfeited and he/she will not be allowed to participate as a stake holder in any of future allotments. In such cases the location shall be allotted to the second highest bidder(H2), willing to match the bid money quoted by H1 bidder.

- (iv) H1 bidder who fails to deposit the requisite bid amount within the stipulated time shall be proceeded against for recovery of bid amount (committed by the H1 Bidder during the e.auction proceedings) by the concerned Deputy Excise Commissioner Executive Jammu/Kashmir under J&K Land Revenue Act 1996 Svt. However, the vend shall again be put to re-auction in the manner as provided for in para 2.3.2 of the J&K Excise Policy 2025-26.
- (v) Successful bidder shall submit self-attested copies of the following documents within five working days of finalization of bid at Excise & Taxation Complex, Rail Head, Jammu.
 - a) Affidavit as mentioned in Para VII(b).
 - b) Recent passport size Photographs.
 - c) Age proof (Birth Certificate/Passport/Matriculation certificate /any other document to the satisfaction of the department)
 - d) Domicile certificate of individual/all partners/directors/ members as may be applicable.
 - e) Copy of PAN of all partners/directors/members as may be applicable.
 - f) Copy of Aadhaar Card of individual/all partners/directors/members as may be applicable.
 - g) Partnership deed in case of a partnership firm/ certificate of registration/incorporation, Articles of Association, DIN number, resolution of BoD.
 - h) Medical certificate that the bidder is of sound mental health to conduct the business.

- i) Any other documents as may be required by the Department.
- (vi) He shall keep the proposed premises ready for making the vend operational from 1st of April, 2025, (the year of allotment).
- (vii) He shall facilitate the verification of the documents/ location and any other check that the Excise Department undertakes before issuance of Regular License.
- (viii) The bid amount shall be for license fee only. Every Licensee shall have to deposit the Minimum Guaranteed Revenue (MGR) on account of applicable Excise Duty/ Fee, as shown against each vend; as per procedure prescribed. MGRs shall be deposited by or before 1st of every month compulsorily by the licensee. The MGR deposited at the beginning of month shall be adjusted against the actual amount of duties accruing on the stock of liquor lifted by the retailer. Any Duty/Fee over and above the monthly installment of MGR shall also be remitted in advance before lifting the liquor from wholesaler. Failure to deposit the 1st installment of MGR on due date shall automatically lead to suspension/ cancellation of the license. In that case, the department reserves the right to distribute the MGR proportionally among other successful vends in the area.

In case of failure to deposit the subsequent installments of MGR of the month on due date, the ETO concerned shall suspend the sale of the vend without any notice under an intimation to the DEC (Executive) and the Excise Commissioner and the same shall be opened only after payment of installment provided it is deposited within seven bank working days. In case the installment is not deposited within seven bank working days, the license shall be deemed to have been cancelled, his EMD shall be forfeited, and the vend shall be put to re-auction.

The MGQ indicated for each vend shall be for the entire policy year. Every licensee shall have to lift Minimum Guaranteed Quota (MGQ) of JK Special Whisky/ JK Country Liquor Brands as shown against each Vend. The revenue deposited against the MGQ will be

considered part of the MGR. The licensee may, with the approval of the Excise Commissioner, transfer his quota from one retail vend to another retail vend for retail sale of JKSW/JK Country Liquor during the currency of license. For this purpose, the licensee of the transferring retail vends may apply to Deputy Excise Commissioner, (Executive) concerned alongwith consent letter of the transferee licensee. The Excise Commissioner, may grant permission for transferring the same, if in his opinion it is expedient to do so in the interest of government revenue on payment of Quota Transfer Fee of Rs 2.00 per 750 ml bottle of JKSW/JK Country Liquor. This shall be allowed only after lifting of 15 percent of the MGQ of his retail vend. The transferee licensee shall be bound to lift the transferred quota failing which he/she shall be liable to deposit the prescribed duties/fee on the same quantity of JKSW/JK Country Liquor.

For any other exigency related to non-operation of an allotted vend, the Excise Commissioner shall take appropriate steps as he may deem fit in the interest of Government revenue and regulation of trade including shifting of the vend to the suitable location even outside the Excise Range with revenue/tourist potential.

- (ix) The EMD of the successful bidder shall be released at the end of the term of the license period. In case of any outstanding due against the licensee, the EMD amount shall be adjusted at the discretion of the department.
- (x) The successful bidder will submit a Solvency/Immovable Property Certificate duly issued by the competent Revenue Authority in respect of the immovable property situated in the UT of J&K, equivalent to 100% of the Minimum Reserve Bid Value/Price or not less than 50% of the Minimum Reserve Bid Value/Price (remainder as Bank Guarantee) clearly mentioning the Khasra number, revenue village and description of property and ownership/lease/title and possession etc of the property within the period prescribed at Para 2.3.8 of J&K Excise Policy, 2025-26.
- (xi) The successful bidder shall submit character certificate issued by District Superintendent of Police.

XIV. PROCEDURE WHERE THE HIGHEST BIDDER FAILS TO FULFIL THE CONDITIONS SUBSEQUENT:

In case the highest/ successful bidder for a particular location fails to deposit the bid amount within period as specified in XIII (i), or to deposit an advance Minimum Guaranteed Revenue of the month within 05 working days of issuance of license or as the case may be or fails to make available for inspection a suitable/eligible premises after declaration of result of the bid before 31st March, 2025 or fails to make operational the premises from 1st of April, 2025 or within 5 days from issuance of Temporary License after re-auction or as the case may be, the earnest money paid/duties/fee/Bid amount etc shall be forfeited and the vend shall be allotted to second highest bidder (H2) provided that he/she matches the price quoted by H1 bidder or put to reauction. Further successful bidder/licensee shall also have to lift the Minimum Guaranteed Quota of JK Special Whisky/Country Liquor and duties/fee paid by him on account of such Quota shall also be considered as part of MGR of the month.

XV. Payment of duties and License fee

The payment of all duties/fee etc. applicable to the JKEL-2 vends as mentioned in the J&K Excise Policy 2025-26 shall be paid by the licensee/successful bidder as per procedure/manner prescribed in the J&K Excise Policy 2025-26/instructions issued by the department.

XVI. MODIFICATION OF THE BID DOCUMENT:

The Government in the Finance Department is the competent authority for any modification in this document. However, the Committee for the supervision of the auction process as constituted in terms of para XVII, shall clarify any doubt or difficulty that may arise in the interpretation of the terms and conditions.

XVII. SUPERVISION OF THE AUCTION/ ALLOTMENT PROCESS:

The process of allotment shall be supervised by a High-LevelCommittee to be constituted by the Government.

XVIII. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS BEFORE ISSUANCE OF REGULAR LICENSE:

Verification of particulars/documents furnished by the successful bidder shall be carried out by the Committee/Officer authorized by the Excise Commissioner before issuance of regular license. The successful bidder shall be obligated to extend full cooperation in the verification process.

XIX. PUBLICATION OF THE LIST OF SUCCESSFUL BIDDERS:

The list of successful bidders shall be given wide publicity and also be displayed at a conspicuous place in the office of the Excise Commissioner/official website.

XX. ALL LICENSES TO BE SUBJECT TO THE J&K EXCISE ACT, 1958 SVT. AND RULES AND NOTIFICATIONS ISSUED THEREUNDER:

All licenses shall be granted subject to the provisions of the J&K Excise Act and the Rules/ Orders/ Regulations/ Instructions/Policies framed thereunder as applicable to the U.T. of Jammu & Kashmir during the period of license.

XXI. TERM OF LICENSES ISSUED THROUGH THIS PROCESS:

All licenses granted under provisions of the J&K Excise Policy 2025-26 shall determine on 31st March of the year following the year of allotment irrespective of their date of allotment.

XXII. CLOSURE OF VEND ON ACCOUNT OF DISTURBANCE TO PUBLIC PEACE, COURT ORDERS, ETC.

In case the vend is not allowed to operate on account of court orders, objections by local inhabitants, public institutions or any other reason beyond the control of the licensee, he shall be allowed by the Excise Commissioner to arrange an alternate premises in the area as specified in Para (IX) of Bid Document within a period of 30 days subject to payment of all duties/fee on account of MGR (along with interest/penalty, if any) for the time granted within 3 Bank Working

Days of such closure. In case, he fails to do so, the license shall be deemed to have been cancelled from the date of closure of the business, and no compensation, refund or any claim whatsoever including that of the EMD/ MGR of the month/License fee/duties/fee etc., shall lie against the Government on account of such closure. In that case, the department reserves the right to increase the MGR of the operational vends in the area.

XXIII. The Government reserves the right to add/delete/de-notify/change any of the locations/cancel the auction process in respect of all/any of the location(s) without specifying any reason at any time prior/during or after the auction process.

XXIV. In case any location could not be allotted for any reason, same shall be put to re-auction.

XXV. JURISDICTION OF COURTS:

All disputes in respect of any issues that may arise from the process of allotment shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts in Jammu & Kashmir only.
