- ii. Premises Clearance Certificate. (As per clause 2.4.8 of Excise Policy 2022-23 and clause IX of Bid Document 2022-23).
- iii. Character Certificate. (As per clause 2.4.3 (5) of Excise Policy 2022-23 and clause VI (e) of Bid Document 2022-23).

The relaxation is however, subject to Hon'ble Court directions/order, contrary to it, if any.
