Subject: Shelf life of Beer in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir.

ORDER No: 75 -EC of 2023

DATED: 03 - 05- 2023

In exercise of powers conferred under Section 4-B of the Jammu & Kashmir Excise Act, 1958 and afore recommendation from the Distillery Wing, it is hereby ordered that shelf life of Beer manufactured in the UT of J&K for local consumption/export and imported from outside UT of J&K shall now be 9 months from the date of manufacture.

However, the shelf life of Beer being imported from outside UT of J&K shall be subject to the guidelines/conditions of the manufacturing State/UT/BIO Country.

All the wholesale trades/retailers shall store the Beer as per the standard conditions of storage for maintenance of its shelf life.
